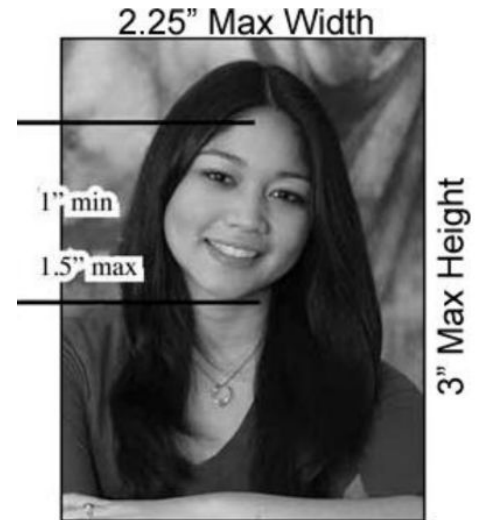
2026 Dragon Yearbook

It is **NOT** required to have a professional take your senior portrait. We will have Martin Photography take school photos at the beginning of the school year that can be used in our yearbook and seniors are able to have photos taken that day or on retake day if they miss the first day. If you do not submit a photo, or your submitted photo does not meet the outlined specifications below, a student's junior photos may be used.

Photo specifications

Senior photos submitted to the yearbook must be:

- Headshot only....No props, hoods, pets, etc in photo
- Must be in color
- Minimum 2.25" wide, 3" height, and 300 dpi preferred
- Head size (top of hair to bottom of chin): min 1" max 1.5"
- Indoor, with a solid, simple background is suggested.



NOTE:

Do NOT cut the head/hairline at the top of the photo

Outdoor background can be used but not suggested

Only head and shoulders will be in the yearbook photo

The GHS yearbook and administration reserves the right to refuse a photo not meeting specifications
